**Read Matthew 1:18-25, Matthew 4:1-17, Luke 23:18-49, Luke 24:1-12, Romans 6:1-14,
Romans 10:8-10**

1. List the variety of ways people think Jesus helps them in their lives. To say it another way, what good does it do to believe in Jesus? Do all of these ways correspond with understanding Jesus as the Lord of their life?
2. When the Apostle Paul says that Jesus saves those who call on His name (Romans 10), what do most people think Jesus is saving you from? Watch the video again. How does the video help to inform your understanding of being saved?
3. Read Genesis 3:1-15 and Matthew 4:1-17. What similarities in those two passages do you find in the way Satan deals with God's word of promise?
4. In Genesis 3:15, God talks about what Jesus will do to Satan. How does this relate to Matthew 4?
5. What does the word "lord" make you think? Can you think of both positive and negative ways people think of the word lord? After watching the video, talk about what it means to have Jesus as Lord.
6. When Jesus died on the cross, He took on your sin and suffered the consequence of your sin, which was death. How does this relate to Jesus being your Lord? In what ways does being resurrected from the dead make him the Lord? How does this give you freedom? (read Romans 6:1-14)
